Position Purpose Ensures identification and individualized education meeting the needs of students who

are gifted and talented by providing advanced curriculum, enrichment units, instruction in

processing skills, and effective growth experiences.

Essential Duties

- Knowledge of curriculum and instruction.
- Ability to interpret data.
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Screen new and referred students for possible gifted identification.
- Coordinate the process to identify gifted and talented students at assigned schools, including review of student data and testing of students.
- Assist teachers to develop and provide gifted and talented students with alternative course work through curriculum modification, acceleration, etc.
- Develop and coordinate a continuing evaluation of the gifted and talented program and implement changes based on the findings.
- Consult with parents, administrators, counselors, teachers, community agencies, and other relevant individuals regarding gifted and talented students.
- Develop and implement plans for the curriculum of the gifted and talented program assigned and show written evidence of preparation as required.
- Prepare lessons that reflect accommodation for individual student differences.
- Plan and use appropriate instructional/learning strategies, activities, materials, and equipment that reflects accommodation for individual needs of students assigned.
- Use technologies in the teaching/learning process.
- Compile, maintain, and file all physical and computerized reports, records, and other documents required.
- Reinforce the vision and mission of the division.
- Perform related work as required by the director of curriculum.

- At least five years of teaching experience
- Strong communication skills; ability to write and speak clearly and accurately
