



### **Use Your Noodle!**


Give your child a bag of colored pasta. (See the directions for making colored pasta on page 5.) Ask him/her to sort the pasta according to color. Then, ask him/her to tell you what he/she did.

Example: "I put red pasta in this group. This group has purple pasta and this group has yellow." Next, have your child sort the pasta according to shape. Have him/her use words which describe the pasta shapes, such as curly, round, etc. Finally, have your child sort the pasta according to size. He/she may make only two sets at first—large and small—but soon will begin experimenting with graduated sizes. Have your child discuss the choices he/she made for sorting the pasta.









### Sort It!

Fill each of several margarine tubs with objects such as buttons, cereal, blocks, coins, etc. Give your child an egg carton or muffin tin. Using index cards, provide pictured labels which show the attributes of the objects in the tubs, such as color, size, shape, etc. Have your child choose a tub of objects and use the labels to place the objects where they belong.


