Capitalization is important for titles of books, movies, and other published works. Follow these rules:

- RULE:** Capitalize the first and last word in a title.
- RULE:** Capitalize all verbs and nouns in a title.
- RULE:** For other words, use lowercase if the word has four or fewer letters. Use a capital if the word has five or more letters.

Titles include names of:

Books
Newspapers
Magazines
Short stories
Poems
Plays
Movies
Songs
