
I Need to Sit Down!

- *Your "person" must be able to sit in your chair without falling out.
- *You have 45 minutes to design and create your chair.

<u>Materials:</u> *scotch tape *glue *masking tape

*craft sticks *construction paper *poster board *anything else that you teacher puts out for you



<u>Tools:</u> *scissors *crazy scissors *rulers *pencils *crayons and markers
