

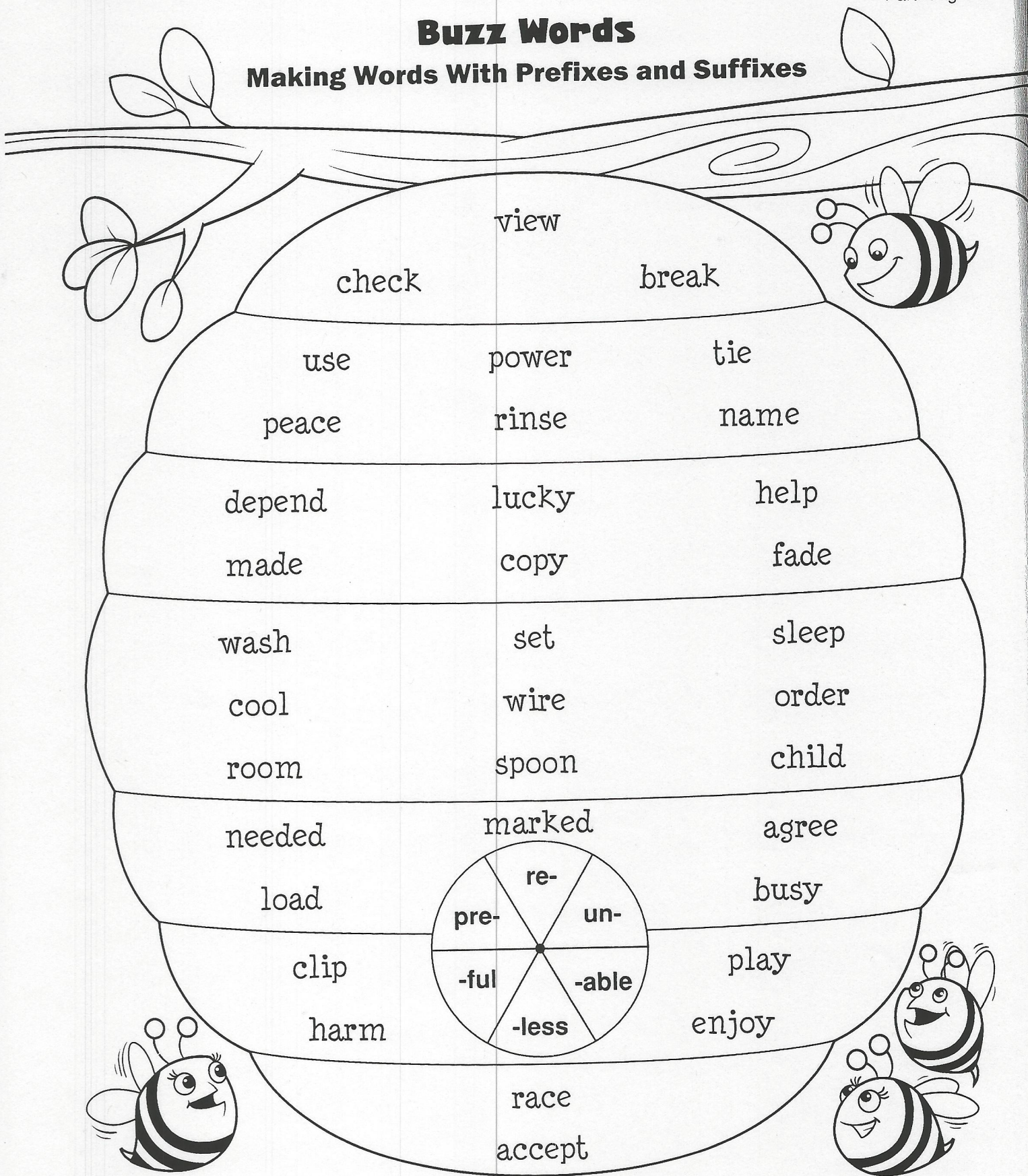

Directions for two players:
